- Stay and Play** runs every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday charged at £4.25 per session. Children do not need to be pre-booked for this. A late pick up charge of £3.50 is applied if children are not collected by 5.10pm. Siblings of Prep children may stay until 4.15pm any day (including Wednesday) without charge, to link with the optional Prep finish of 4.20pm. (Please pick up PP child first).

Details of clubs are below.

- **Golf** – £65 per term inclusive of all equipment and awards. Golf is a great skill to learn from a young age with many benefits including co-ordination, balance and sportsmanship, as well as being a business tool for the future and a sport for life.
- **Asian Tasty Treats** – £62 per term. This is a wonderful cookery club with Josie Budd. Each week the children bring home delicious meals and snacks. They need to bring a box to transport their food home.
- **Ballet** – £62 per term. Grouped by age, these classes are a wonderful way to develop the skills and discipline of dance, as well as to improve coordination and core stability. Girls require a leotard and skirt (preferably pink for Nursery and Reception, blue for Year 1 and 2) pink ballet shoes, socks, plus hair band if needed. Boys require white T-shirt, PE shorts and black ballet shoes.
- **Street Dance** – £62 per term. Years 1 and 2 only. Great for developing a sense of rhythm whilst building coordination and fitness. Children require leggings or shorts and a T-shirt.
- **Story Makers** - £42.50 per term, run by Mrs McMaster. This club involves creating stories and books, using drama, art and design.
- **Cello** – £5 per lesson plus £10 instrument hire. This is a group lesson taught by Miss Coles. Six places available but I am happy to start a waiting list!
- **Violin** – £5 per lesson plus £10 instrument hire. This is a group lesson, taught by Mr Fisher.
- **Art and Craft** – £42.50 per term, run by Miss Minogue. An opportunity to make colourful creations – the only restriction is your own imagination!
- **Recorder Karate Club** – £16 per term, run by Mrs Berry. In this club children develop their theory and aural skills, while learning to play some funky tunes. Children can work towards different levels of ‘belts’ which they can ‘wear’ on their recorder. Own instrument preferred, though these can be borrowed from school. Children will need their own copy of Red Hot Recorder Tutor book 1.
- **Circus Skills** – £62 per term. In this club children have great fun whilst improving coordination and learning some tricks!
- **Puppets** - £42.50 per term, run by Mrs Roberts. Using sewing and other techniques, children will make puppets and other items through the term. They will get a chance to put on their own puppet shows too.
- **Tennis / Dinky Tennis** – £40 per term, run by Jon Rolnik of Game, Set and Match Tennis Academy, children play a range of games and activities developing their skills for tennis.
- **Mini Maestros (invitation only)** – run by Mrs Berry. This is the training string orchestra which feeds the Prep School orchestra.
