Sewing guide

New uniform

Second-hand uniform

Sports kit and equipment

We provide all the balls and basics for games lessons. If your child is in Year 2, they'll need a mouth guard for rugby and hockey. A temporary mouth guard from a local sports shop works well, but OPRO custom fitting is also available. For hockey, children will also need their own shin pads.

Labelling everything

From bags and blazers to boots and bibs – everything your child wears or brings to school should be clearly labelled with their full name. Nametapes are best, but anything permanent will do the job.



Blazers: label to be sewn just above the inside pocket



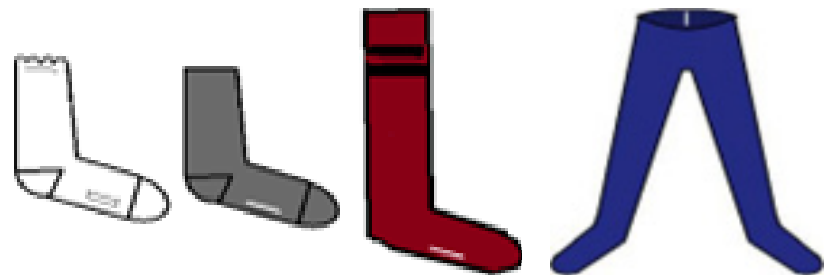
Ties: label to be sewn the reverse of the tie, towards the thicker end



Shirts, blouses, dresses, coats, jumpers, cardigans, hoodies, pyjama tops, T-shirts, vests, crop tops, bras: inside the collar or the top of the centre back (for collarless items)



Trousers, shorts, skirts, skorts, tracksuit bottoms, swimwear, pyjama bottoms, underwear: inside the waistband, centre back

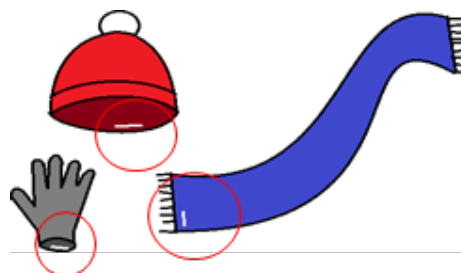


Socks (school and home): along the bottom of the foot, on the outside – each sock must be named

Tights: inside the waistband, sewn vertically so they can stretch



Towels, bedding, flannels: near the corner, along the short edge



Hats, scarves, gloves: inside the hatband, on the scarf's bottom edge, and inside the cuff of the gloves

Getting kitted out

Uniform options: List A or List B

You'll find two main uniform lists: A and B. You're welcome to choose either list for your child – but once chosen, the two can't be mixed and matched.

So, if you're going for grey socks and trousers from List A, you'll need to stick with that list throughout.

Likewise, navy socks and tartan kilts belong to List B. We expect all children to be fully dressed in either List A or List B by the time they start school in September.

There are a few essentials that all children must have, no matter which uniform list you choose.
